The US Lacrosse Association invites committed individuals to be trained as Women's Lacrosse Umpires. Each Umpire agrees to enforce and interpret the rules which are designed to maintain the "spirit of the game" and to ensure the safety of the players at all levels.

The spirit of the game includes the philosophy that

1. The game should flow as continuously as possible, not burdened by an inordinate number of rules requiring frequent stops during the game.
2. The outcome of the game should be determined by legal play of the players, not by the interpretation of the rules by the umpire or by the direction during play by the coaches.
3. Players, coaches, and umpires should observe the intent of the rules, making a sincere effort to observe them and not attempting to take advantage of them.

If the game is played in the spirit and players are well coached in the intent and the word of the rules, it is the hope of the US Rules Committee that the game will be a safe one to play and to officiate
